## **CLUB FEES**

The Club fees vary per team depending upon the number of tournaments. The Club fees cover the above tournament entry fees, practice gym rentals, equipment, uniforms, Carolina Region membership, salary, and travel expenses for coaches, and the referee/scorekeeper's clinic. Uniforms include two jerseys, two spandex, two pairs of socks, and a club warm-up tee shirt. (Players will also have the option of purchasing additional clothing and a gym bag.)

The Carolina Select Volleyball Club fees do not cover the player's travel expenses or the registration membership fee for the Carolina Region.
